Classic Vehicle Exhibitors – Conditions for entry

This document contains the terms and conditions of a contract. Exhibitors who do not comply with these terms and conditions may not be accepted in future. Application must be made on this form, no photocopies will be accepted. Any vehicle arriving at the show without a pass will be directed to the Public Car Park, and the standard entry fee will apply. Passes and final instructions will be sent during June and July, once signed entry forms have been received.

1. Definitions

- 1.1 In these conditions "Application Form" means the Exhibitor's application form on which these conditions are printed. "Conditions" means the standard terms and conditions set out in this document and (unless otherwise noted) includes any special terms and conditions agreed in writing between the Organiser and Exhibitor. "Event" means Weeting Steam Engine Rally & Country Show 2023, held at Fengate Farm, Weeting on Friday 14th July to 16th July 2023. "Official" means any person or persons authorised by the Organiser to supervise and oversee the running of the event. "Organiser" means Weeting Steam Engine Rally Trustees. "Site" means all the land upon which the Event is held. "Exhibit" means the exhibit described in this application from "Exhibitor" means the person, or persons, so described in this application form.

2. Entry

- 2.1 No variation of these Conditions shall be binding unless agreed in writing between authorised representatives of the Organiser and the Exhibitor.
- 2.2 The Organiser reserves the right to refuse entry to any Exhibitor at its discretion without giving reasons

3. Requirements

- 3.1 No Exhibitor may enter the Site after 10.00 am or leave the Site before 5.00 pm without the permission of the Organiser, on any day of the Event, including the Sunday.
- 3.2 Exhibits must be on show from 10.00 am to 5.00 pm daily

4. Passes

- 4.1 2 passes will be issued to each Exhibitor as well as a one car pass and one camping pass.
- 4.2 An Exit Pass system will be in force.
- 4.3 Additional passes will only be issued with the permission of the Organiser
- 4.4 Subject to 4.3 above, additional passes can be purchased at the current rates.
- 4.5 Each additional person will be charged the standard entry fee
- 4.6 A pass will only be valid when issued by the Organiser.
- 4.7 If there is a dispute regarding additional passengers, the money requested on admission to the Site must be paid. Any query should then be referred to the Organiser, and the money will be refunded if deemed appropriate by the Organiser.

5. Camping

- 5.1 An Exhibitor with a valid pass may camp on the Site, in the area indicated by the Organiser, from Friday, 14th July 2023 and not before. Other personnel may only camp in the Public Campsite where the standard fee must be paid.

6. Liability

- 6.1 The Organiser will not be liable to the Exhibitor if the Event is cancelled, curtailed or altered in any way due to circumstances outside the Organisers control.
- 6.2 THE ORGANISER ACCEPTS NO LIABILITY TO THE EXHIBITOR FOR BREACH OF CONTRACT, LOSS INJURY OR PHYSICAL DAMAGE OF ANY KIND HOWSOEVER ARISING WHETHER BY STATUTE OR OTHERWISE EXCEPT WHERE DEATH OR INJURY IS CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE ORGANISER, ITS AGENTS OR SERVANTS.
- 6.3 The Exhibitor shall be solely responsible for the Exhibit at all times, whether at the Site, or travelling to or from the Event.
- 6.4 The Exhibitor agrees to keep the Organiser indemnified against all liability whatsoever in respect of any damage or personal injury caused by the Exhibitor, or the Exhibit, or any driver or crew member or others for whom the Exhibitor may be responsible either on the Site, or travelling to or from the Event.

7. Insurance

- 7.1 The Exhibitor undertakes that the Exhibitor and the Exhibit will be covered by Public Liability Insurance for not less than £2,000,000 while the Exhibit is on Site. Additionally, that the Exhibit entered is covered by insurance as required by the Road Traffic Act 1960.
- 7.2 The Exhibitor will provide copies of the Policies or Certificates evidencing Public Liability and RTA Insurance with this document.

8. Compliance

- 8.1 The Exhibitor agrees to comply with any safety requirements and inspections as deemed appropriate by the Organiser at any time.
- 8.2 The Exhibitor agrees at all times while on the Site to comply with Conditions and the reasonable requirements of any Official.

9. Law

- 9.1 This contract shall be governed by the Laws of England.
