Applications must be made on this form, no other type of entry will be accepted. Any vehicle arriving at the show without a pass will be directed to the Public Car Park, and the standard entry fee will apply. Passes and final instructions will be sent during June, once signed entry forms and full payment has been received.

1 Definitions

- 1.1 In these conditions "Application Form" means the Exhibitor's application form on which these conditions are printed. "Conditions" means the standard terms and conditions set out in this document and (unless otherwise noted) includes any special terms and conditions agreed in writing between the Organiser and Exhibitor. "Event" means Weeting Steam Engine Rally & Country Show, held at Fengate Farm, Weeting on Friday 17th July to 19th July 2026. "Official" means any person or persons authorised by the Organiser to supervise and oversee the running of the event. "Organiser" means Weeting Steam Engine Rally Trustees. "Site" means all the land upon which the Event is held. "Exhibitor" means the person, or persons, so described in this application form.

2 Entry

- 2.1 The Exhibitor agrees to the conditions here and overleaf the Organiser to confirm your attendance.
- 2.2 Subject to clause 2.4 below the Organiser permits the Exhibitor to display an exhibit for the duration of the Event, subject to these Conditions.
- 2.3 No variation of these Conditions shall be binding unless agreed in writing between authorised representatives of the Organiser and the Exhibitor.
- 2.4 The Organiser reserves the right to refuse entry to any Exhibitor at its discretion without giving reasons.

3. Requirements

- 3.1 No Exhibitor may enter the Site after 09:00 or leave the Site before 17:00 without the permission of the Organiser, on any day of the Event, including the Sunday.
- 3.2 Exhibitors must have their exhibit on show from 09:30 to 17:00 daily, all three days of the Event, please DO NOT enter if you cannot commit to this requirement.

4 Passes

- 4.1 Two wristbands will be issued to each Exhibitor. Please ensure you are wearing your wristbands on entry, for checking by security.
- 4.2 Additional wristbands will only be issued with the permission of the Organiser.
- 4.3 Each additional person will be charged the standard entry fee.
- 4.4 A wristband will only be valid when issued by the Organiser.
- 4.5 If there is a dispute regarding additional passengers, the money requested on admission to the Site must be paid. Any query should then be referred to the Organiser, and the money will be refunded if deemed appropriate by the Organiser.
- 4.6 Camping passes will be issued if you tick the box overleaf, please display these on entry to Site.

5 Camping

- 5.1 An Exhibitor with a valid pass may camp on the Site, in the area indicated by the Organiser, from Thursday 16th July 2026 and not before. Other personnel may only camp in the Public Campsite where the standard fee must be paid.

6 Liability

- 6.1 The Organiser will not be liable to the Exhibitor if the Event is cancelled, curtailed or altered in any way due to circumstances outside the Organiser's control.
- 6.2 THE ORGANISER ACCEPTS NO LIABILITY TO THE EXHIBITOR FOR BREACH OF CONTRACT, LOSS INJURY OR PHYSICAL DAMAGE OF ANY KIND HOWSOEVER ARISING WHETHER BY STATUTE OR OTHERWISE EXCEPT WHERE DEATH OR INJURY IS CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE ORGANISER, ITS AGENTS OR SERVANTS.
- 6.3 The Exhibitor shall be solely responsible for their exhibit at all times, whether at the Site, or travelling to or from the Event.
- 6.4 The Exhibitor agrees to keep the Organiser indemnified against all liability whatsoever in respect of any damage or personal injury caused by the Exhibitor, or the exhibit, or any driver or crew member or others for whom the Exhibitor may be responsible either on the Site, or travelling to or from the Event.

7 Insurance

- 7.1 The Exhibitor undertakes that the Exhibitor and exhibit will be covered by Public Liability Insurance for not less than £5M while on Site. We would prefer Public Liability cover of £10M. Additionally, that the Exhibit (if applicable) entered is covered by insurance as required by the Road Traffic Act 1960.
- 7.2 The Exhibitor will provide a copy of the Policy or Certificate evidencing Public Liability and RTA Insurance (if applicable) with this document.

8 Compliance

- 8.1 The Exhibitor agrees to comply with all safety requirements and inspections as deemed appropriate by the Organiser at any time.
- 8.2 The Exhibitor agrees at all times while on the Site to comply with Conditions and the reasonable requirements of any Official.

9 Law

- 9.1 The Exhibitor agrees to details being held on the Weeting Rally database for next years rally.
- 9.2 This contract shall be governed by the Laws of England.
